## **Praying for Revelation of the Sins of Omission**

### **SCRIPTURE**

“For I was hungry and you gave me something to eat, I was thirsty and you gave me something to drink, I was a stranger and you invited me in...”

Matthew 25:35–36



### **PRAISE**

### **CONFESSION**

#### **SCRIPTURE**

#### **PRAISE**

We praise You, Lord, for the gift of marriage and family, designed to reflect Your unity and love. Thank You for the cross of Christ, which demolishes hostility and restores broken relationships.



#### **CONFESSION**

Forgive us, Lord, for harboring bitterness and unresolved pain against our spouse or parents. Forgive us for allowing past hurts to divide us and hinder Your blessing in our homes.



#### **PRAYER POINTS**

1. Lord, grant us the grace to forgive long-standing hurts and release bitterness at the foot of the cross.
2. Heal marriages and parent-child relationships that have grown distant, restoring transparency and unity.
3. Empower families to face painful memories through humble, grace-filled conversations, with hearts willing to listen.

### CONFESSION

### PRAYER POINTS

3. Let the blessings of unity described in Psalm 133 be poured out upon our families, bringing peace and joy.

### **PRAISE**

### **CONFESSION**

### **PRAYER POINTS**

3. Help us to bear one another’s burdens, showing compassion and unity as members of Christ’s body.

### **CONFESSION**

### **PRAYER POINTS**
