SCRIPTURE

CONFESSION

Forgive us, Lord, for allowing selfishness, past hurts, and emotional distance to hinder love in our homes. Forgive us for failing to show Christ-like love to our spouse, children, and parents.



PRAYER POINTS

1. Lord, renew our love for our spouse, children, and parents, filling our hearts with Your Spirit.

3. Replenish our “love tanks” so that we may pour out love generously and consistently to those closest to us.

RESTORING DEEPER RELATIONSHIPS BETWEEN SIBLINGS AND THEIR FAMILIES

Praying for God to Reveal Aspects We Have Ignored in Loving Our Siblings

SCRIPTURE

 “For anyone who does not love his brother, whom he has seen, cannot love God, whom he has not seen. And He has given us this command: Whoever loves God must also love his brother.” 1 John 4:20–21

PRAISE

 We praise You, Lord, for the gift of siblings who share our lives so closely. Thank You for the tangible love and support we have experienced through them, which reflects Your care and provision.

CONFESSION

 Forgive us, Lord, for neglecting to express love toward our siblings in tangible ways. Forgive us for ignoring opportunities to care, reconcile, and cherish them as Your gifts to shape us into Your likeness.

PRAYER POINTS

SCRIPTURE

PRAISE



We praise You, Lord, for being the God of justice and reconciliation. Thank You for Your mercy that heals wounds across generations and restores unity among families.

CONFESSION



Forgive us, Lord, for harboring bitterness and passing down stories of betrayal and anger to future generations. Forgive us for perpetuating division instead of seeking reconciliation and forgiveness.

PRAYER POINTS



1. Lord, break the bitter roots of anger and resentment that have been carried across generations.
2. Grant us grace to forgive relatives who acted unjustly, even when it feels difficult.
3. Restore unity among families, replacing hate and anger with Your love and peace.
