SCRIPTURE



“Bear fruit in keeping with repentance.”
Matthew 3:8

PRAISE



Lord, thank You for the gift of renewal through repentance and for drawing us closer to You in intimacy and love.

CONFESSION



We confess that we often neglect hidden sins and unresolved issues, allowing them to hinder our walk with You and our family’s spiritual health.

PRAYER POINTS

Praying for a Deeper Spiritual Intimacy with Our Spouse/Parents

SCRIPTURE



“For the unbelieving husband is sanctified through his wife, and the unbelieving wife is sanctified through her believing husband.” 1 Corinthians 7:14

PRAISE



Lord Jesus, thank You for showing us that spiritual intimacy in marriage and family can transform generations and draw hearts closer to You.

CONFESSION



We confess that we often neglect spiritual disciplines as couples and families, allowing distance to grow between us and You.

PRAYER POINTS



1. Strengthen spiritual intimacy in marriages and families through prayer, Scripture, and shared devotion.
2. Sanctify unbelieving spouses, children, and parents, drawing them closer to You through the faith of their loved ones.

RESTORING DEEPER RELATIONSHIPS BETWEEN SIBLINGS AND THEIR FAMILIES

Praying for Jesus to Encounter Our Siblings and Their Homes

SCRIPTURE



“Watch out! Guard yourselves against every form of greed, for one’s life does not consist in the abundance of possessions.”

Luke 12:15

PRAISE



Lord Jesus, thank You for teaching us to value love and faith over possessions, and for calling us to display Your priorities in our families.

CONFESSION



We confess that we have often allowed wrong priorities, bitterness, or neglect to hinder our love and witness toward our siblings.

PRAYER POINTS



1. Strengthen love and unity among siblings, even where faith differences or rejection exist.
2. Let our lives display Christ’s priorities, drawing siblings and their families closer to You.

RESTORING RELATIONSHIP WITH EXTENDED FAMILY MEMBERS

Pray for Deepening Our Spiritual Bonding and Having a Deeper Fellowship with Them

SCRIPTURE

“Go therefore and make disciples of all nations...” Matthew 28:19



PRAISE

Lord Jesus, thank You for the gift of extended family and for the spiritual bonds that can reflect Your love and mission.



CONFESSION

We confess that we have often neglected the spiritual well-being of our extended families, settling for superficial relationships instead of genuine fellowship.



PRAYER POINTS

Deepen our spiritual intimacy and fellowship with extended family members, so Christ's love may overflow through us. Strengthen those who know You to fulfill Your mission, and draw those who do not yet know You into Your grace.

RESTORING FAMILIES OF OUR CHURCH

Praying Against the Spiritual Forces Attacking Our Church Families

SCRIPTURE

“Finally, be strong in the Lord and in His mighty power. Put on the full armor of God, so that you can take your stand against the devil’s schemes.” Ephesians 6:10–11



PRAISE

Lord Jesus, thank You for being our shield and protector, and for giving us Your Word and Spirit to stand firm against the enemy.



CONFESSION

We confess that we have often neglected to guard our families with prayer and the armor of God, leaving room for the enemy’s schemes.



PRAYER POINTS

1. Protect church families from the attacks of the enemy, strengthening them with the armor of God.
2. Deliver children, youth, and couples from temptations and distractions, empowering them to live victoriously in Christ.



FAMILY CHALLENGE



Pray for People in Minority Communities Who Often Feel Marginalized

SCRIPTURE



“When a foreigner resides among you in your land, do not mistreat them. The foreigner residing among you must be treated as your native-born. Love them as yourself...” Leviticus 19:33–34

PRAISE



Lord Jesus, thank You for showing us that every person is made in Your image and worthy of love, dignity, and belonging.

CONFESSION



We confess that we have often ignored or neglected minority communities in our neighborhoods, failing to reflect Your compassion and justice.

PRAYER POINTS



- Help us to love and serve marginalized neighbors with Christlike compassion, treating them with dignity and respect.
- Let our neighborhoods reflect Your Kingdom values, where minority communities experience belonging and spiritual care.

SCRIPTURE
